“Embracing our roots and **celebrating tradition today!**”

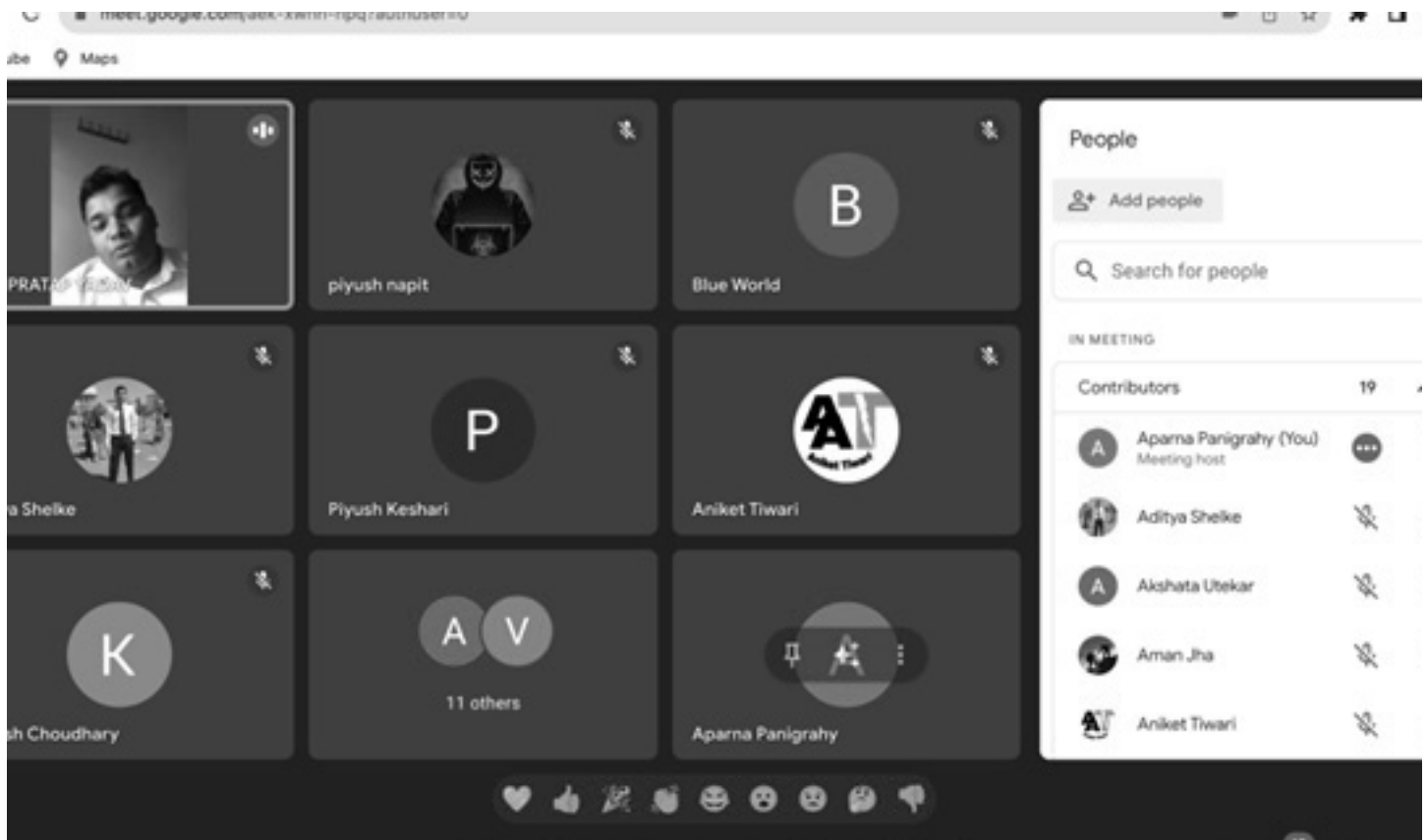
