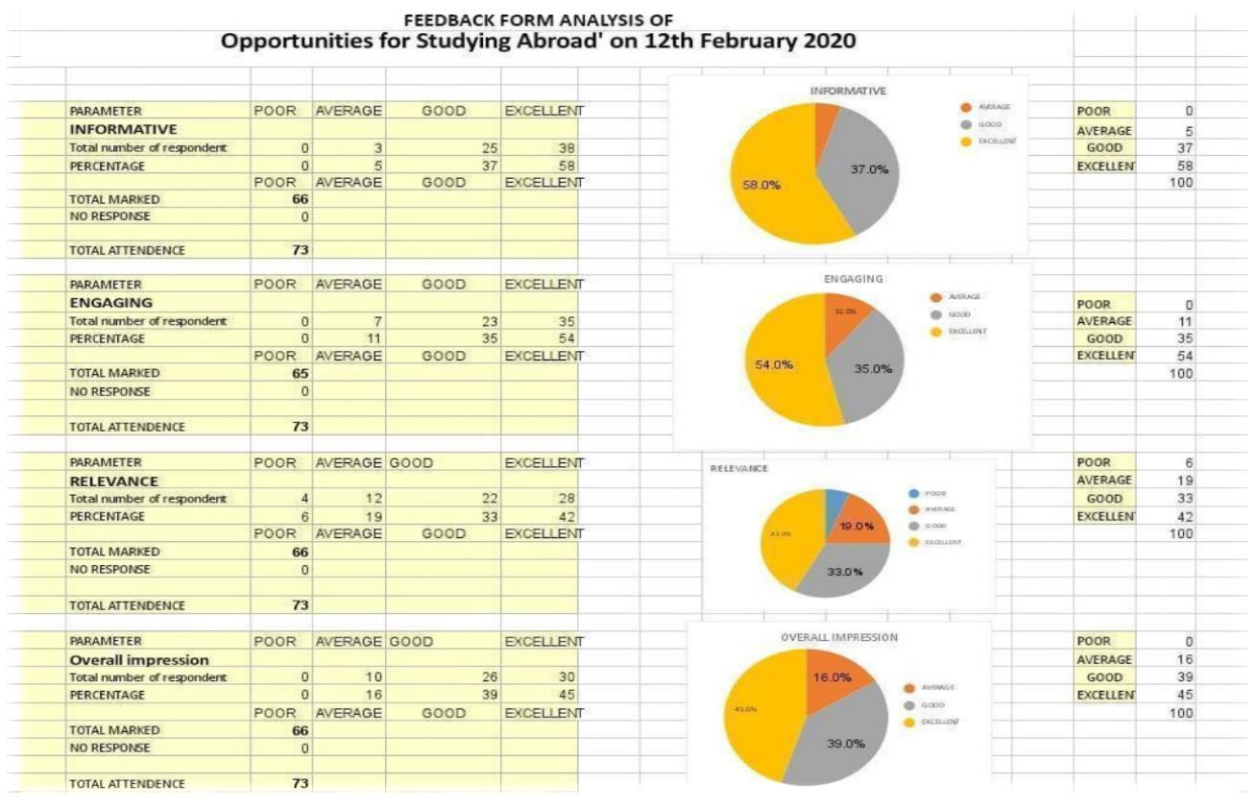


Report on Opportunities for Studying Abroad
