Over 260 students attended the interactive Zoom session and benefitted from the webinar.



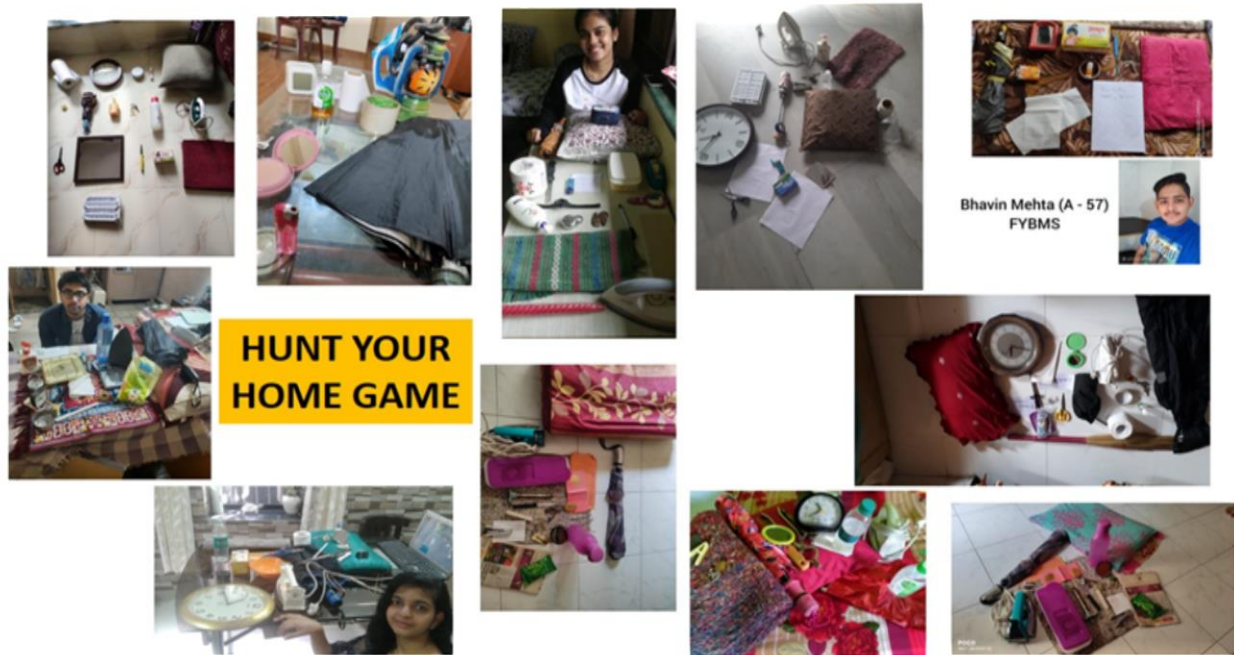

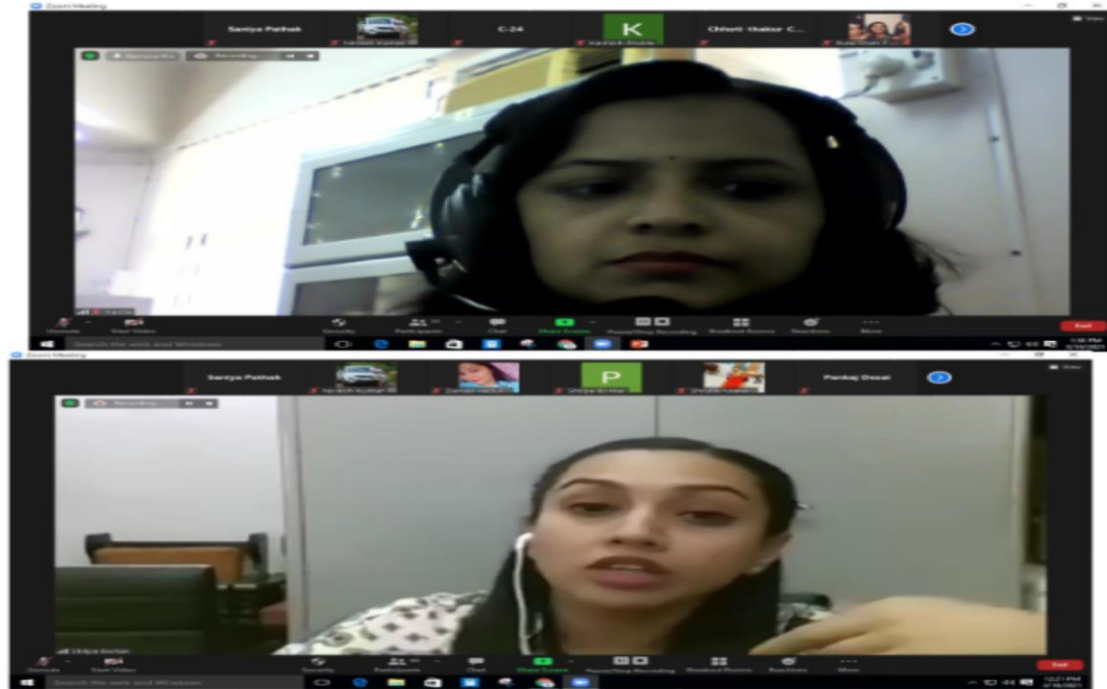

Q) Rate the following parameters on the basis of your experience of the webinar

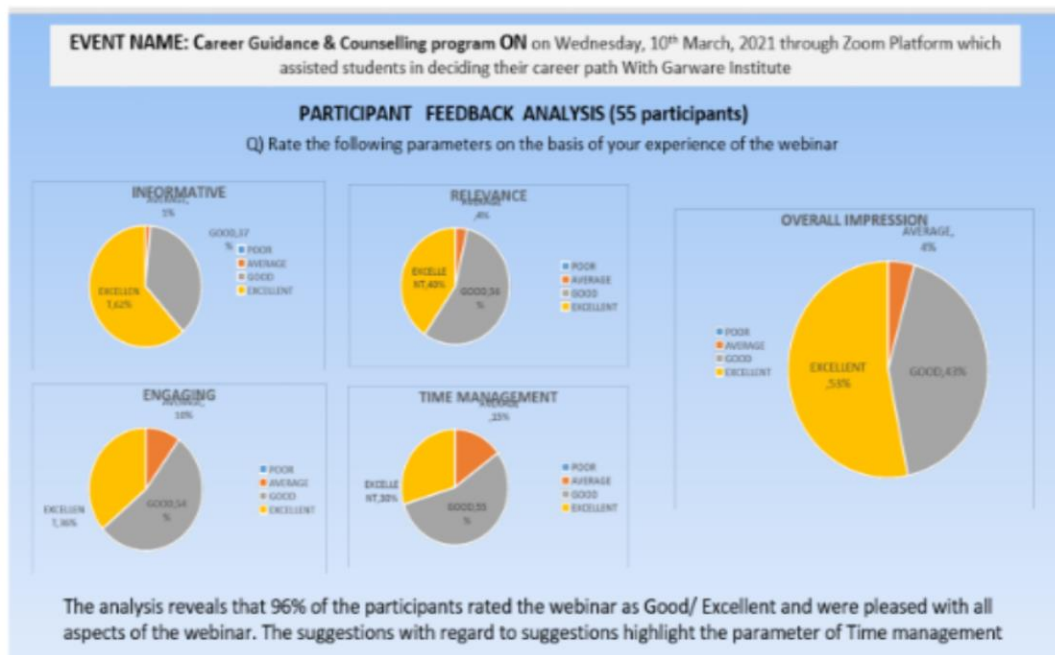

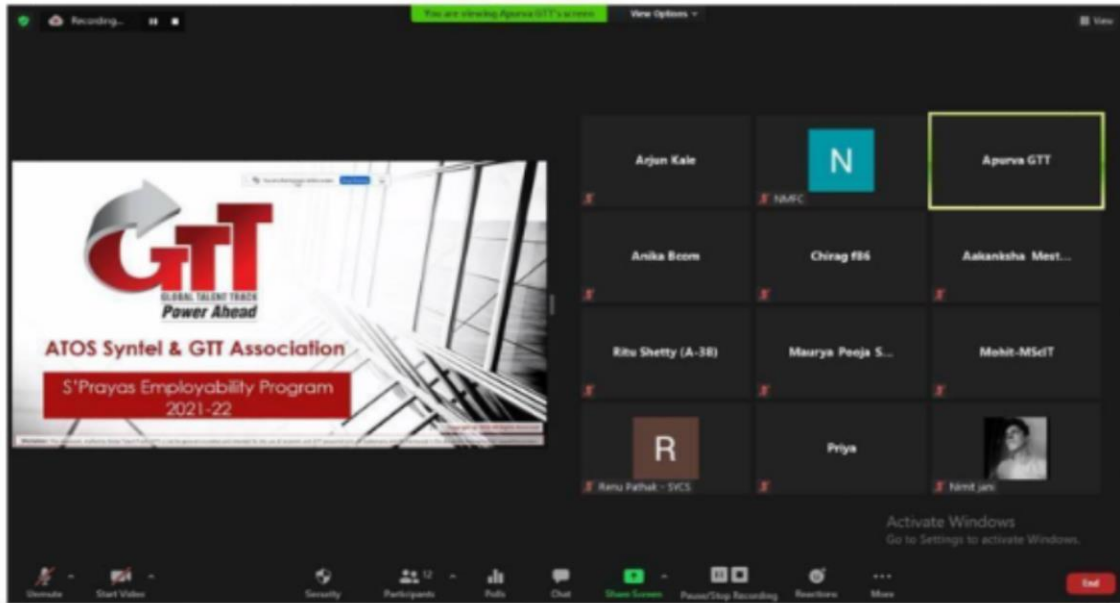

The takeaway from the program was well appreciated by the participants.



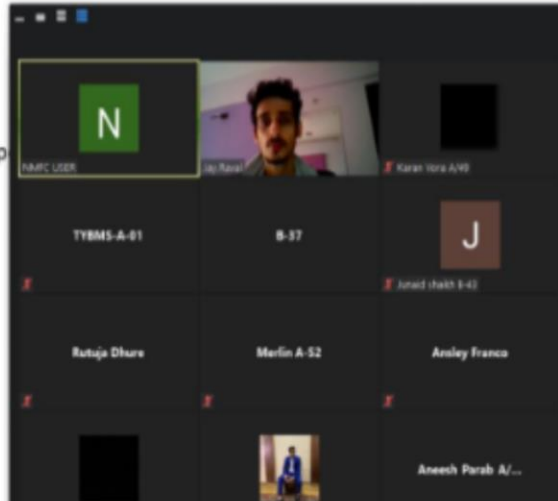

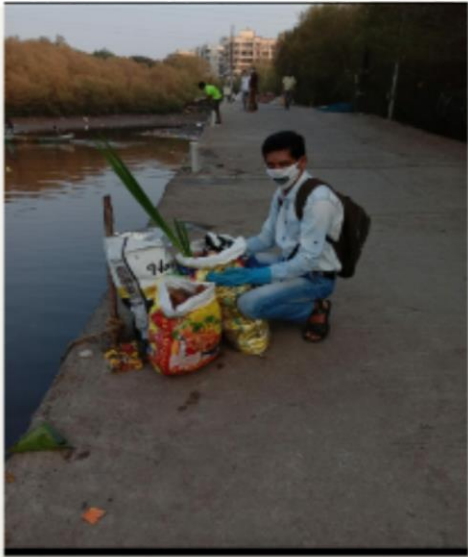
