### Do Midget Submarines Fit Into Indian Navy's Littoral Defence Plans?

The Indian Navy (IN) has not shown much interest in the program despite the demand for the midget submarine already and even at later stages of development in underwater capabilities for covert operations and surveillance missions in shallow waters by the Marine Commandos (SMARC), but SOV-400 doesn't seem to fit the bill.

SOV-400 is a new midget submarine design from Korea's Daewoo that was developed at the Daegu Shipyard. It is currently generating interest for its high cost of production and its manufacturing without getting support from the Indian Navy.

The company will continue improving its design and capabilities to draw customers from the export market. According to open sources, L&T has no further plans for development but is in the high cost of production for their manufacturing without getting support from the Indian Navy.

**AN AGE-OLD WAIT FOR PROCUREMENT**

The Indian Navy still keeps quiet about its needs despite its open plans to be the first to acquire Midget submarines.

According to open sources, the Navy has been acquiring these vessels in 2008 and sent a Request for Proposal (RFP) to Indian shipyards, including Hindustan Shipyard Limited, ALCO, and Pipavav Shipyard. According to media reports, the Navy initially only intended to purchase five of these ships, but later on, the number of submarines may have increased.

Following the 2018 tense attack at Mumbai in 2008, in which the attacker's hideout in India's fishing boat and hidden in the shallow waters off the coast of the city in a midget submarine to reach Bandra Pier and the Hassan Bridge, a short distance from the city's Gateway of India monument, it was believed that the midget submarine was used as part of efforts to improve its operational capabilities.

Mangalore Dock Shipbuilders Limited (MSL) started work on the prototype of the vessel last August, but due to delays in the procurement and deployment are being kept under wraps. Additionally, MSL had requested cooperation in the Design, Development, and Construction of both Large Unmanned Undersea Vehicles (LUVs) which would be able to transport two small torpedoes for coastal surveillance, to the sea arm of the Indian Navy. The vessel carries two light torpedoes, lay mines, and carry payloads for coastal surveillance and also fishing.

**MIDGET SUBMARINES FOR INDIA**

These submarines are typically smaller vessels with lower than the larger classed, with a crew of only two to seven people and are primarily employed for special operations. They frequently collaborate with mother ships, from which they are launched and recovered, and also house the crew and support staff.

They are sometimes called "Cobra" or "Inshore Delivery Vehicle" (IDV). In India, this includes the present class, a type of vessel which demonstrated proficiency, which allows these submarines to be used to assess that other submarines cannot track due to shallow waters. "Inshore Operation Vessel" (IOV) is also referred to as a small, low-observable, autonomous, self-sufficient vessel that combines the advantages of stealth and high speed from a combination of SOV and high-speed surface vessels.

A crucial and long-standing addition to India's marine commando (SMARC) capability is midget submarines.
