These skills make it easier to form relationships with people, create trust, dependability, and lead teams.

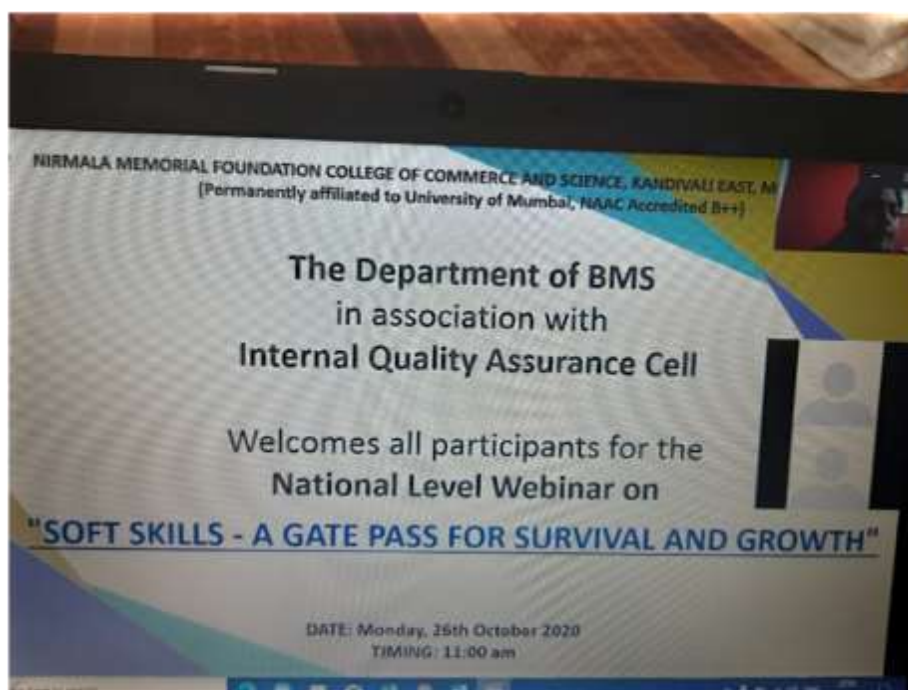

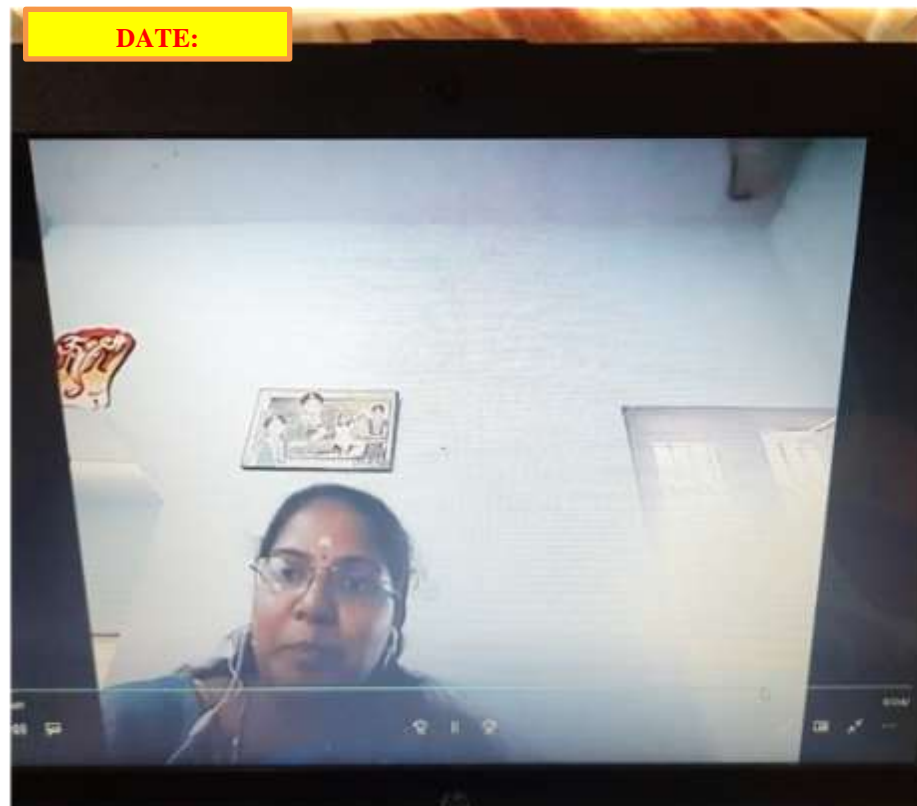
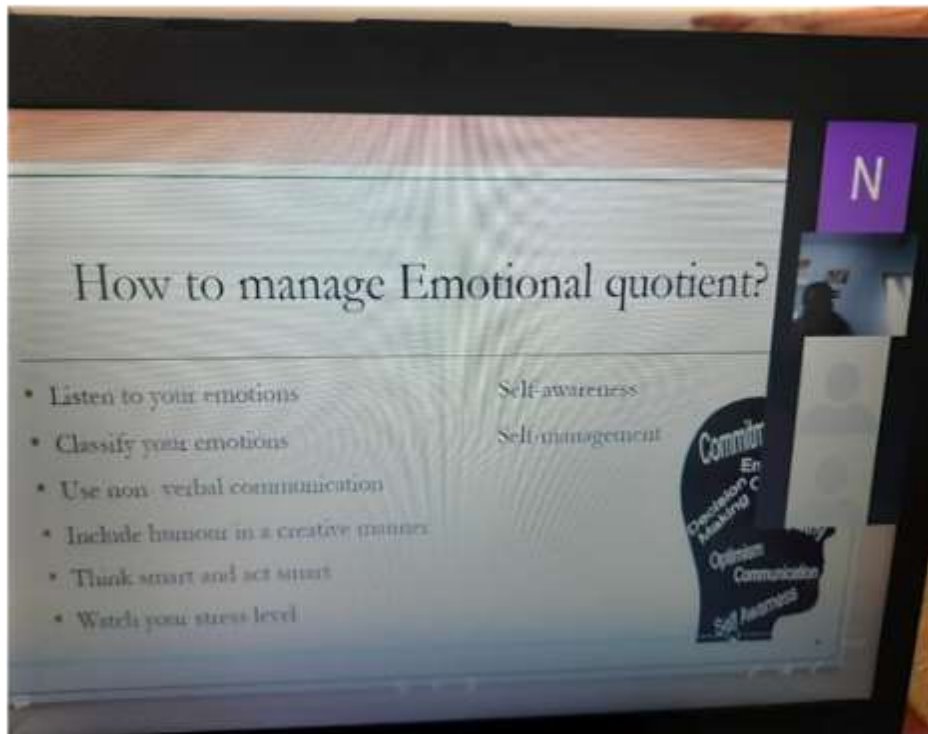
“Soft Skills – A Gate Pass for Survival and Growth” on Monday, 26th October, 2020 at 11:00 am.

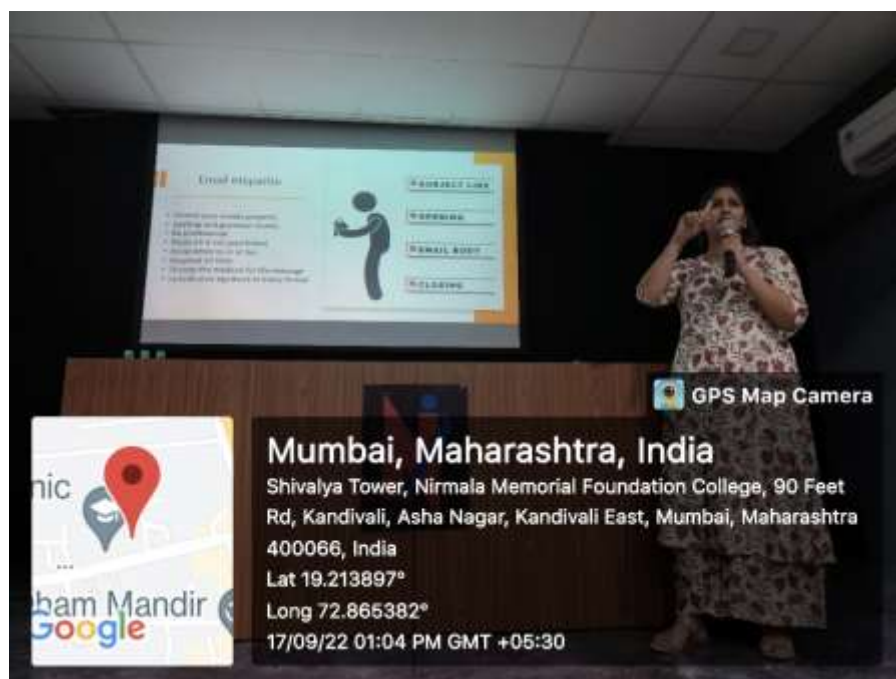


## SIX-DAY PERSONALITY DEVELOPMENT CAMP

## **SEMINAR-TIPS AND TRICKS TO CRACK THE INTERVIEW**

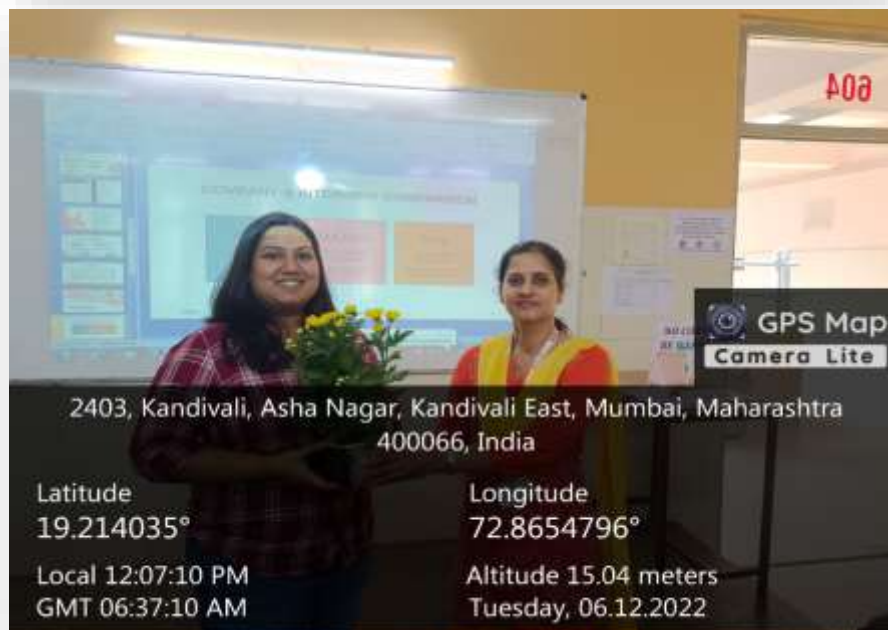
