The takeaway from the program was well appreciated by the participants.



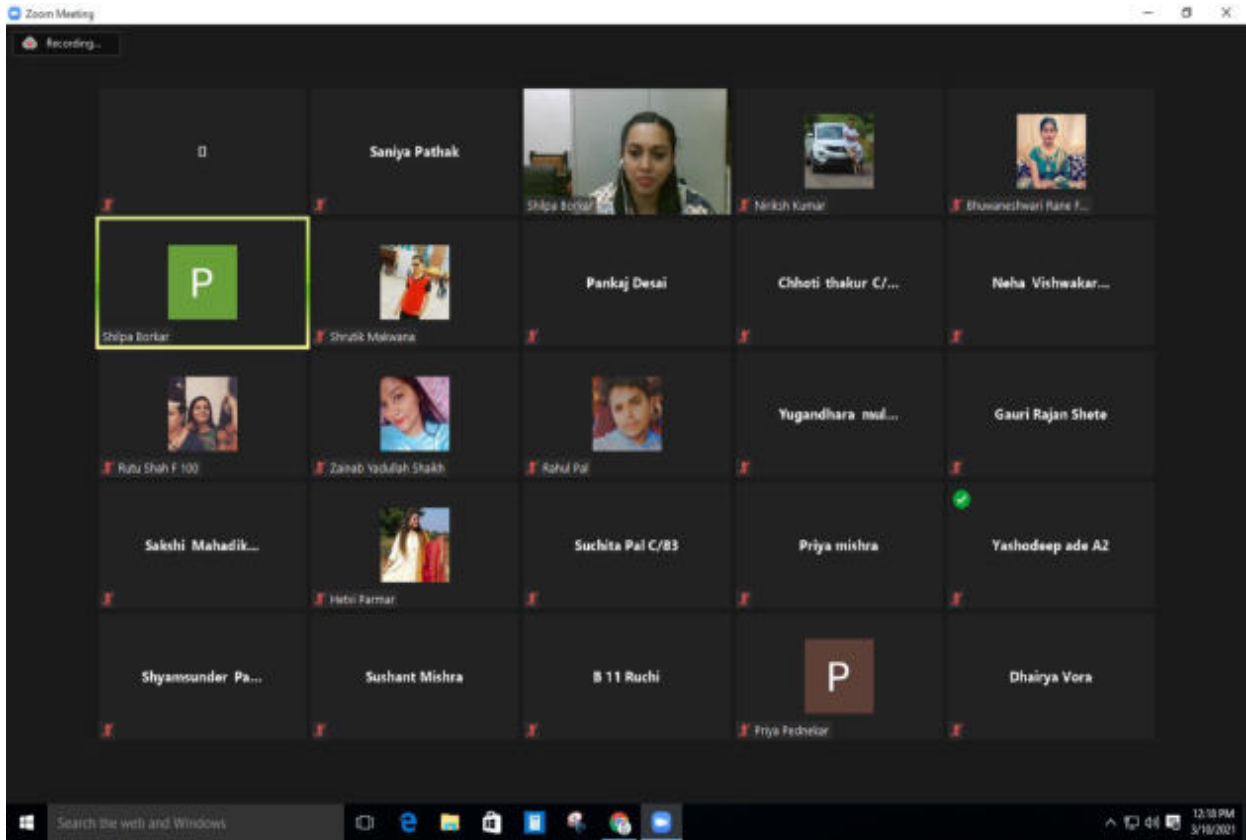
- i) Career Mentoring Tool

Around 55 Participants took the benefit from the workshop.

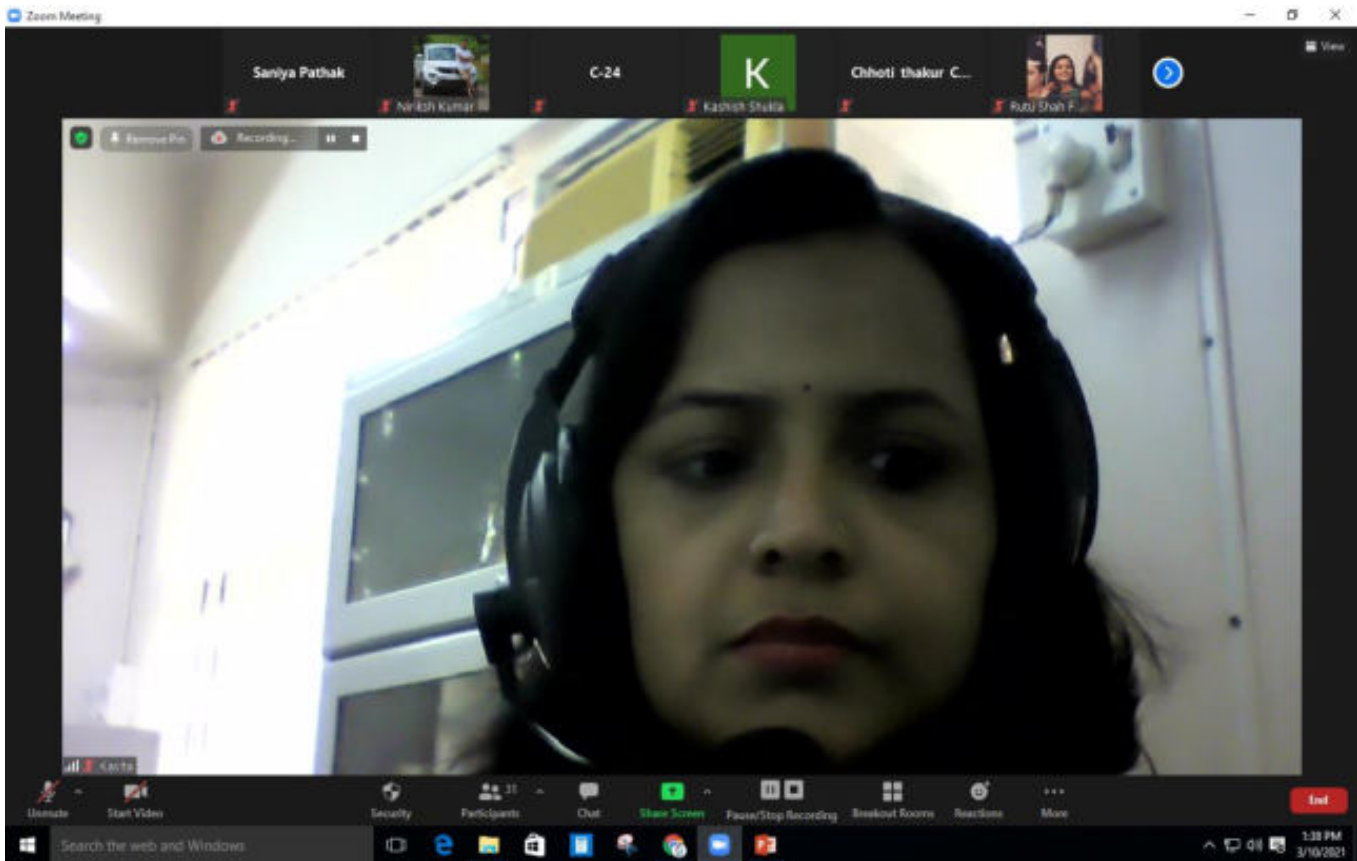

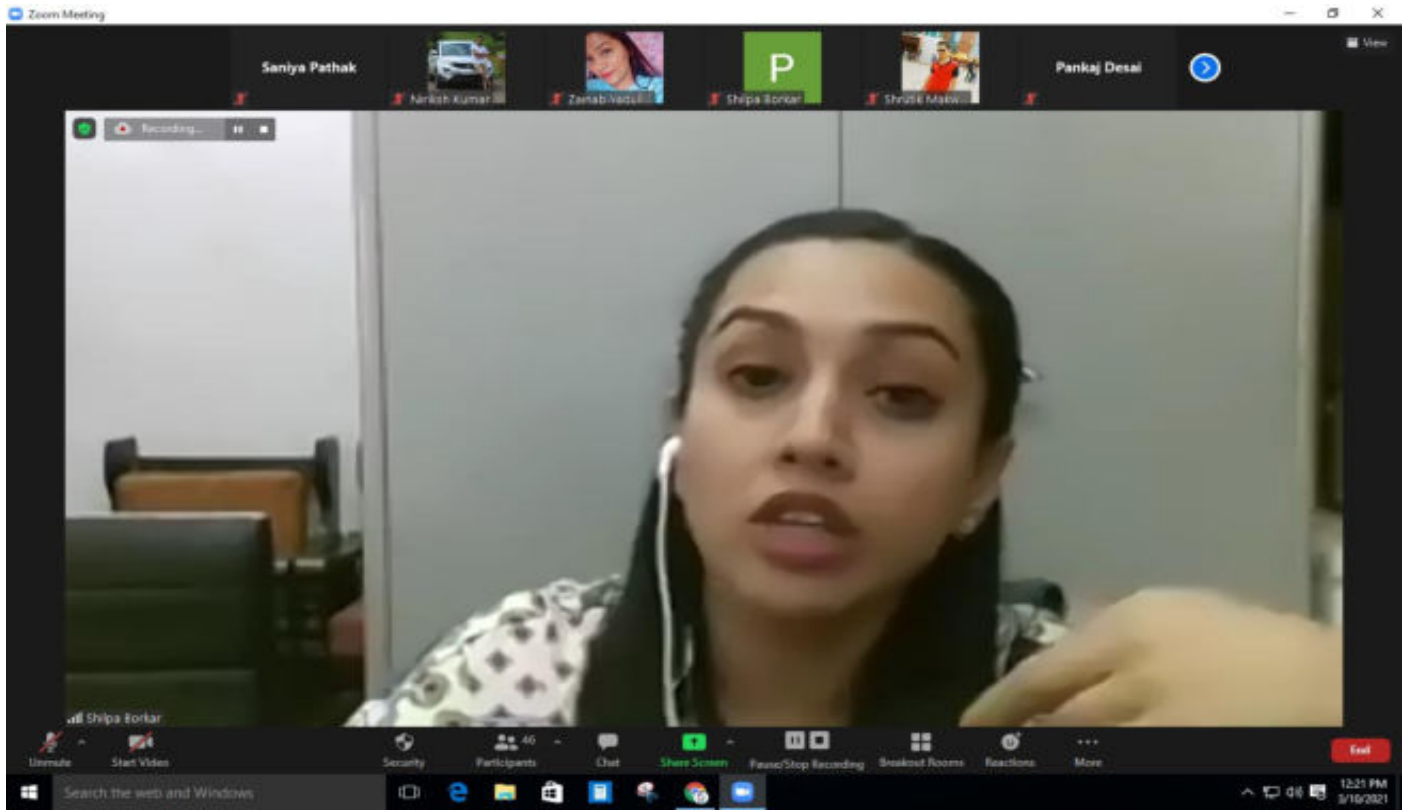

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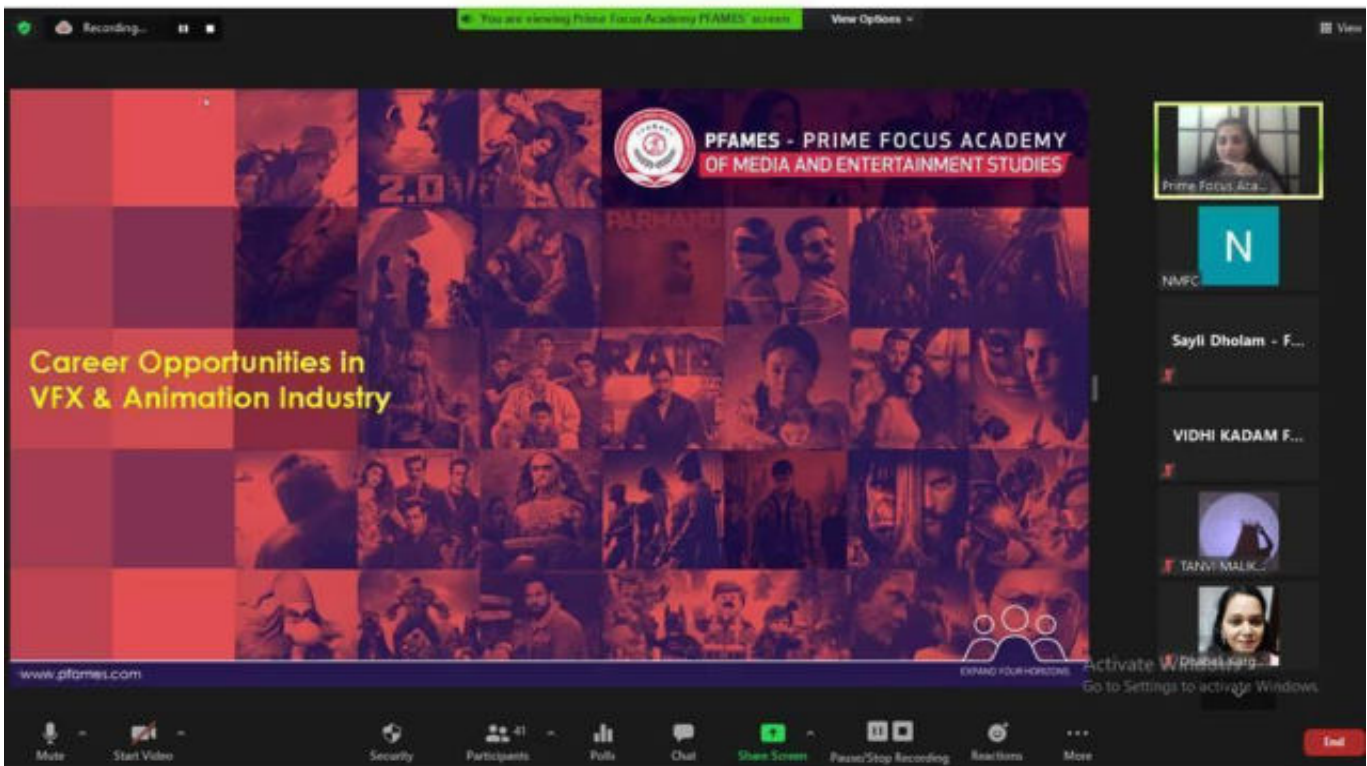
Report on Career & Education fair

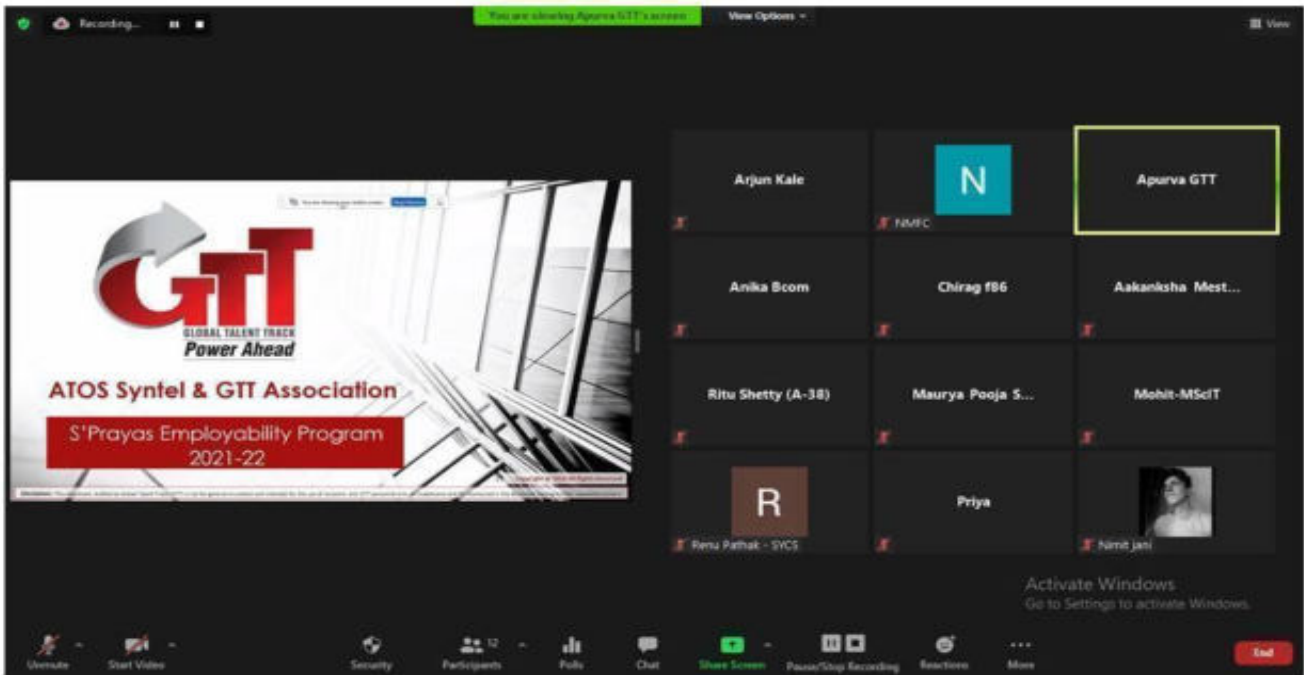

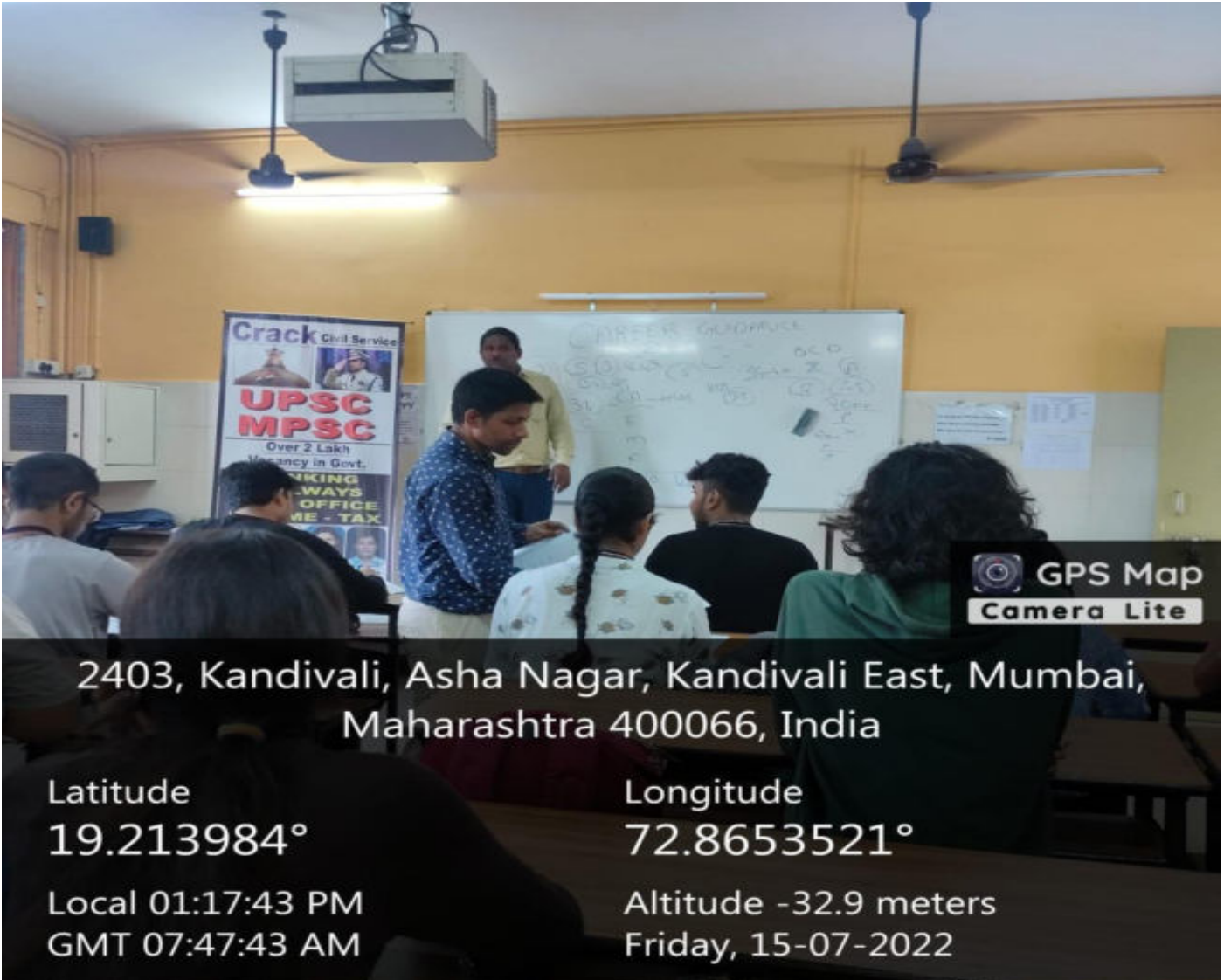
Report on Seminar on Career counselling on government Jobs

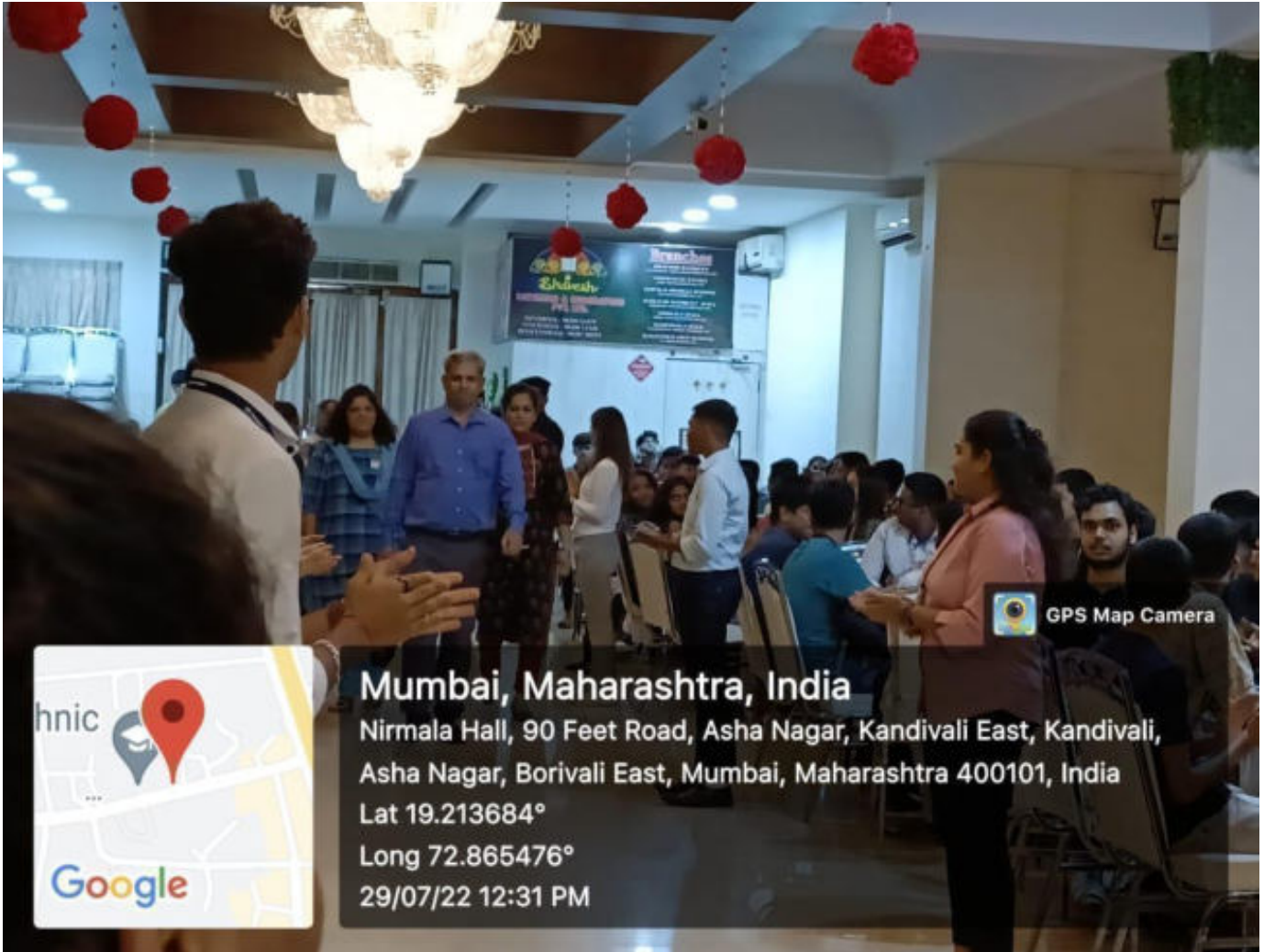

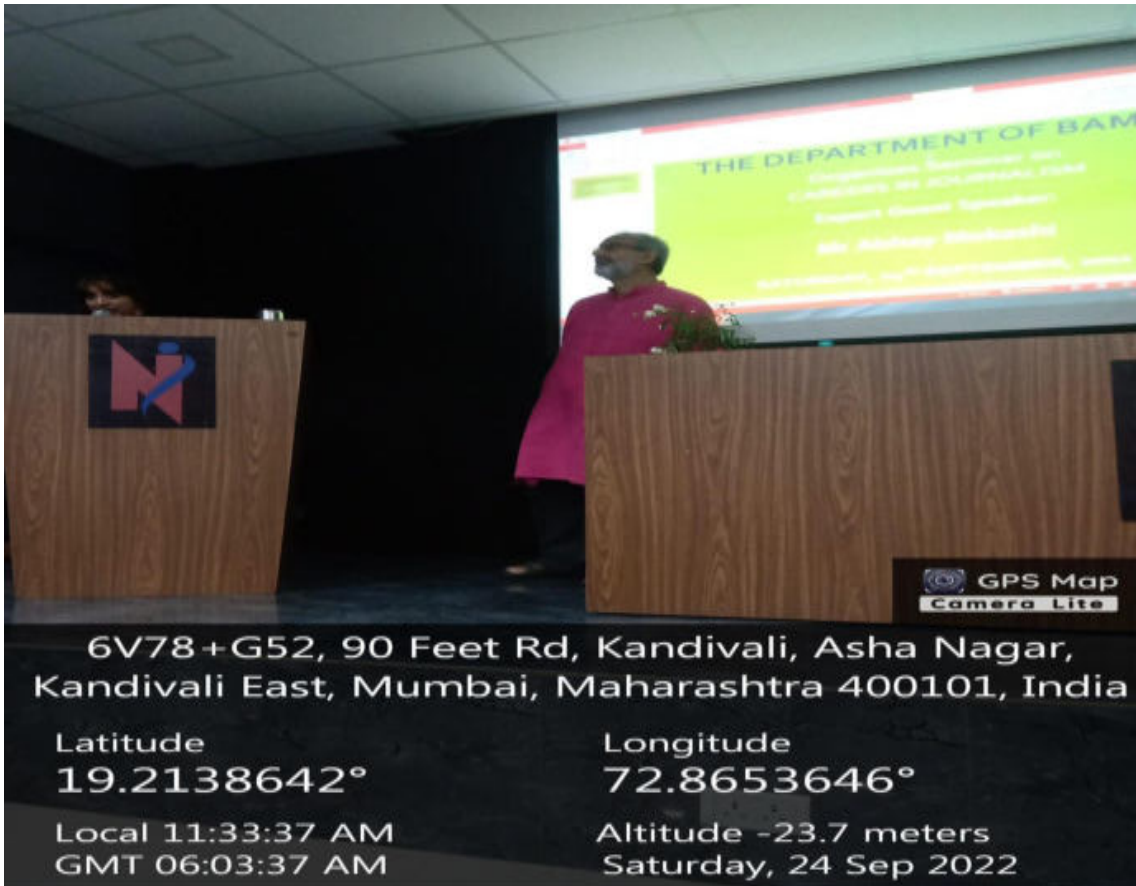
