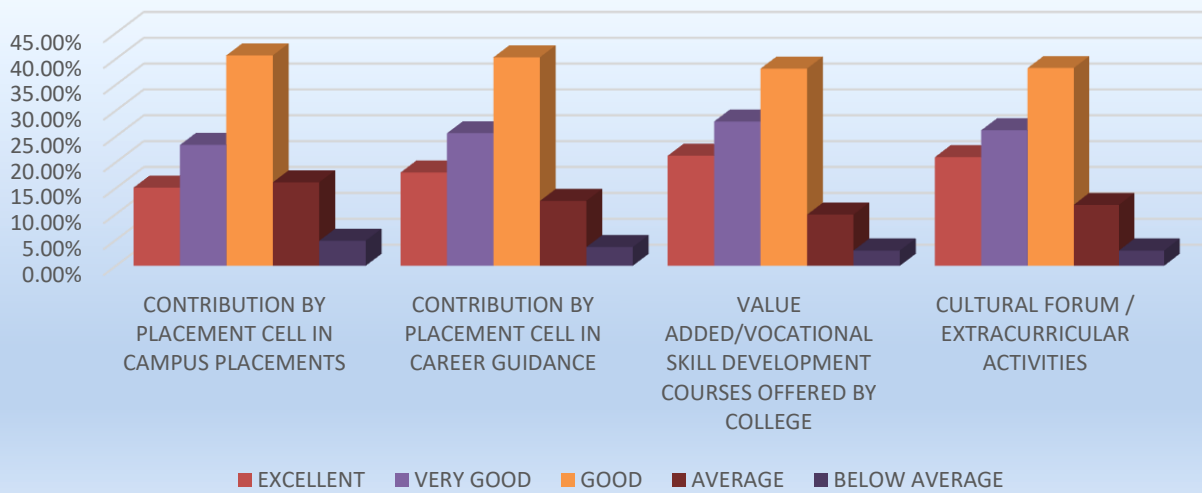

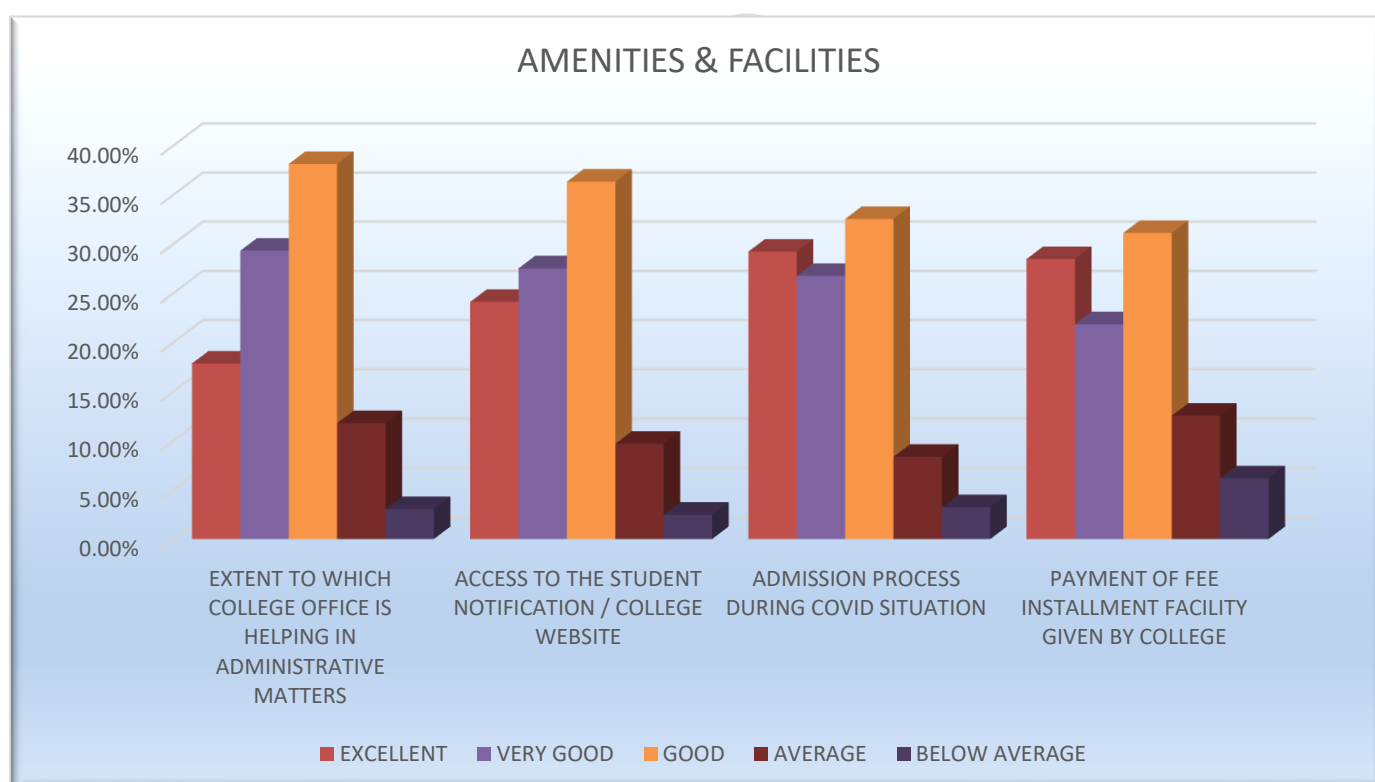
CO-CURRICULAR & EXTRA CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES OFFERED BY COLLEGE

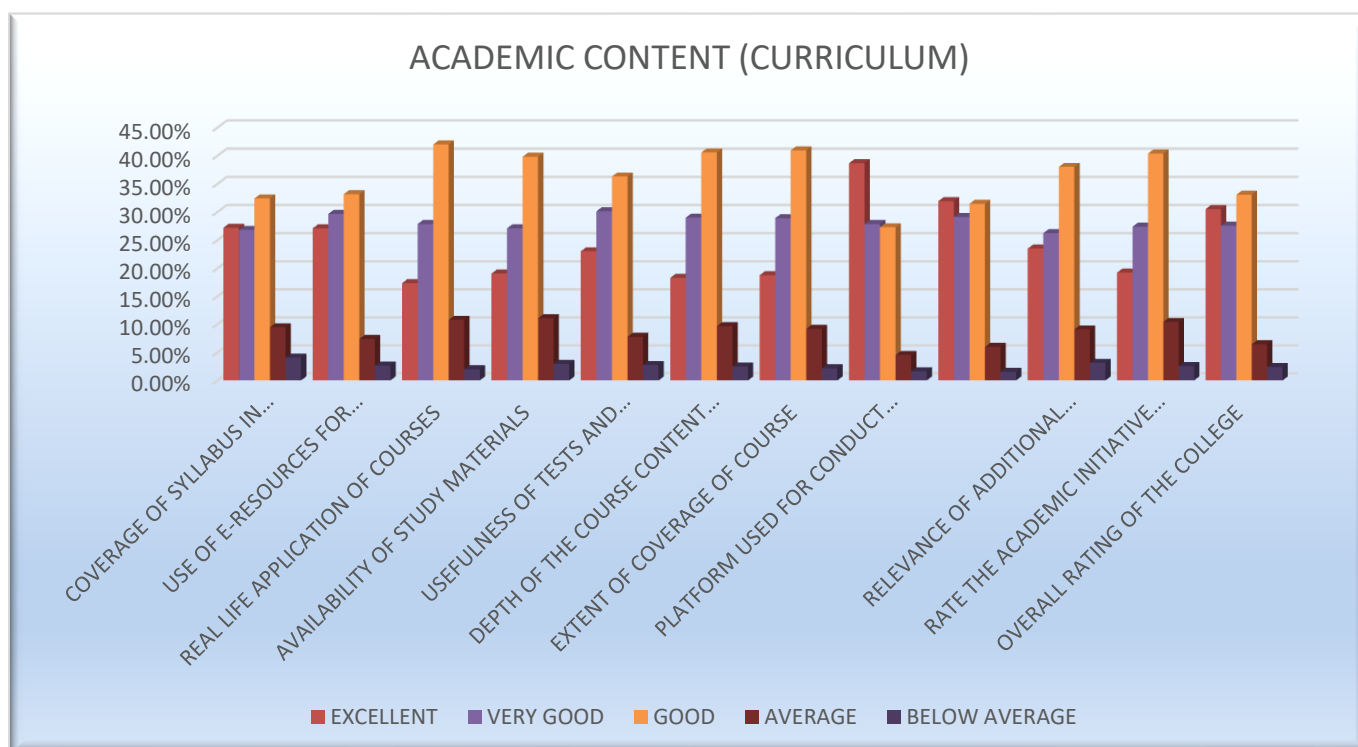
