ENERGY CONSERVATION POLICY

Nirmala Memorial Foundation College of Commerce and Science follows sustainable environmental and energy consumption practices. The college has taken an initiative to minimise the use of electricity and is also using alternate energy source. Few highlights of our initiatives are:

- · College campus uses LED lights
- Students and staff members are educated on 'Energy Conservation' by placing posters near electric switches

To achieve the objectives the institution has following policies.

LIGHTS:

- The institution uses only LED bulbs to illuminate the facility.
- The switches are appropriately allocated to lights so that there are no unnecessary lights being used.
- The students and staff members are instructed to switch off the lights before leaving the room
- Every room has provision of natural light to minimise use of electric bulbs.
- The college uses green energy in its campus.



ENERGY CONSERVATION POLICY

AIR CONDITIONERS:

- Each Classroom is having fans installed so as to cover entire room
- Air conditioners are used as per season and can be used only if there is a considerable number of students and staff members using the room.
- For any complaint or service requirements, the staff members can contact the floor allotted peons who look into the repair work.

MAINTENANCE:

- A structured complaint form is kept is used, which the complainant can fill addressing the issue pertaining to computer labs that need to be remedied.
- Under the central administration of the institution, a dedicated team of maintenance staff for electrical equipment and fittings has been appointed.

Hence, the institution aspires to minimise carbon footprint by reducing the usage of energy and using alternative sources of energy.
